Eucharistic Adoration Revival: A day encouraging Eucharistic Adoration in parishes is taking place in Mt St Anne's on Saturday 24th August. For now, here are some quotes from Pope Francis to encourage adoration in their parish.

"We need to recover a sense of awe and adoration before the Eucharist knowing it is the real and loving presence of the Lord".

"The rediscovery of prayer through Eucharistic Adoration is the source of hope for the Church to grow and take root".
